Filling the Tool Shed

Tools on loan to the playground project can be delivered to the Tool Trailer at Montgomery Park from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday, October 1. All tools will be stored in locked shed when not in use.

All tools lent to the playground build will be returned in sign-in condition or replaced!

Dryden's Boy Scout Troop 24 will be camping at the park during the build as a security team. According to our tool coordinator, Joe Lucia, our biggest tool needs are routers and impact drivers. "We have no laminate routers and need 10 and we have 1 regular router and need 4. We are also sorely hurting on cordless impact drivers."
